FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Sanjay Kumar Tanwar in case registered by way of FIR No.299 dated 29.09.2015 at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa under Section 409 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 21.04.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dalip Singh from Police Station Dabwali, District Sirsa who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute. Though

Mr. Deepak Sabharwal, Advocate representing respondent No.2/DHBVNL has tried to oppose grant of relief to the petitioner but he could not convince the Court of the criminal investigations sought to be made.

Appreciating the submissions of the two sides and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.04.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
