FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

It is *inter alia* argued that petitioner-Sumer Singh, happens to be the owner of disputed property measuring 22 Kanals and has been legitimately held its ownership in the final adjudication by this Court and that to undo the effects of the judicial verdicts, private respondents No.5 to 9 have intimidated the petitioner regarding which two different FIRs have already been registered against them and he and his family members have been receiving threats at the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Munish Sharma, Asstt. Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. A copy of the paper book be handed over to him.

In the light of the submissions made and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to ensure due protection of life, property and personal liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 9, in accordance with law. However, anything observed herein would not come in the way of due recourse of law.
