Vakalatnama filed on behalf of respondents No.5 to 12 is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is licenced excise dealer and he had set up his liquor vend in the market as per policy of the Haryana Government and the same was demolished by the private respondents and his prayer is mainly for providing protection. However, Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly conceded that by now he has not made any representation to the police authorities and contended that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition at this stage with liberty to move appropriate petition for protection before the police authorities and if need be, he be allowed to approach this Court again.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
