Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.64 dated 12.10.2015 under Sections 295-A, 452, 447, 427, 148 and 149 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Sekhwan, Distt. Gurdaspur, on the basis of compromise dated 12.10.2016 (Annexure-P2).

Vide order dated 24.04.2017, petitioners and respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

In compliance of the order dated 24.04.2017 of this Court, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala on

04.05.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide his covering letter No.128 dated 08.05.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur vide letter No.8051/RKT dated 09.05.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala, the compromise between the parties is without any pressure, coercion and has been done with the free consent of the parties.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.64, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
