Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.58 dated 10.09.2015 under Sections 452, 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Jhander, District Amritsar (Rural) on the basis of compromise.

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 21.04.2017, the petitioners as well as respondents No.2 to 6 were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

In compliance to the order dated 21.04.2017 of this Court, the parties had appeared before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate on 09.05.2017

and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide Endorsement No.47 dated 25.05.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur vide Endorsement No.4882-R dated 30.05.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ajnala, the compromise between the parties is genuine and without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.58 is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
