Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions in the context of investigation in respect of FIR No.200 dated 13.02.2017 registered under Sections 186, 304, 332, 353 IPC at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar.

At this stage, the factual allegations cannot be appreciated for want of material on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner confined his prayer only to the extent of protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioner from being invaded at the hands of private respondents.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, A.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let requisite copies of the petition be supplied to her by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage.

At this stage, without meaning anything on merits of the case, respondent No.3 is directed to take into consideration the pending representation moved by the petitioner on 03.04.2017 and take appropriate action in accordance with law, without being swayed away by any consideration in terms of pleadings or anything recorded in preceding part of the order. Respondent No.3 would be at liberty to collect material by devising his own mechanism. Let the representation be decided within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
