The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.174 dated 04.07.2015, under Sections 21/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station City, District Kapurthala.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner was of 110 grams of contraband.

Pleadings on record indicate that the petitioner had been extended benefit of interim bail awaiting the report of the Chemical Examiner. It is the case of the petitioner herself that as per report of Chemical Examiner, the contraband was found to be containing Alprazolam. 110 grams of such contraband would be construed as commercial quantity.

Under such circumstances, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Faced with such a situation, learned counsel appearing for the

petitioner submits that he would not be pressing the instant petition rather the petitioner would duly surrender and thereafter file an application seeking regular bail.

As per prayer made by counsel, present petition is dismissed as not pressed.
