The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 114 dated 15.07.2015 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Divison NO.7, District Jalandhar City.

On 18.01.2017 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in sub-para of Para-4 of the petition, there is mistake in the name of Harpreet Kaur as it should be Gurpreet Kaur as mentioned in the FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner may file appropriate affidavit for correction of the same.

Notice of motion returnable on 22.02.2017.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail in FIR No.114 dated 15.07.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of

Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Division No.7, District Jalandhar City, on furnishing of her bail bonds amounting to Rs.10,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. Petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when required and fully cooperate with the Investigating/Arresting Officer.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 18.01.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
