ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.156 dated 30.05.2016, registered under Sections 363, 366-A IPC (Sections 366, 342, 376, 506 IPC added later on) and Section 4 of POCSO Act, Police Station Old Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for over a year and the prosecutrix has been examined and the trial would take time. The counsel further submits that the girl had accompanied the petitioner with her own consent.

The State counsel submits that the girl was a minor and she was missing for three days and she was recovered from the custody of the petitioner and after recovery she had made allegations of rape against the

petitioner and she stood by her statement even before the Court and the complainant is yet to be examined.

There are allegations of rape of a minor girl. The allegations are serious. No case for bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
