The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 114 dated 15.07.2015 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Divison No.7, District Jalandhar City.

On 18.01.2017 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion returnable on 22.02.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner-Ashok Singh alias Ashok Kumar, makes a statement that the petitioner would deposit the amount of Rs.2,50,000/- in the Registry of this Court within a period of 4 weeks from today.

In that view of the matter, in the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail in FIR No.114 dated 15.07.2015, registered under

Sections 406, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Division No.7, District Jalandhar City, on furnishing of his bail bonds amounting to Rs.10,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. Petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when required and fully cooperate with the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

It is made clear that if, by the next date, the amount as stated above, is not deposited, this ad interim order shall come to an end automatically without reference to this Court.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 18.01.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
