Petitioner-Gaurav has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.113 dated 14.08.2016, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar, under Sections 323, 324 and 326 read with Section 34 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner is stated to be armed with *datar* and simple injury is attributed to him. He is not the main accused.

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In pursuance of the interim order dated 03.05.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 03.05.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
