Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per his information, the investigating agency has prepared a cancellation report with respect to FIR in question.

Learned State counsel concedes this fact stating that the cancellation report has been approved by the higher police officers, but this report is to be filed in the Court of Illaqa Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to Illaqa Magistrate to decide the cancellation report expeditiously.

Under these circumstances, the Illaqa Magistrate is directed to dispose of the cancellation report expeditiously, preferably within 2 months of its filing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that in view of such statement of the State counsel, the petition be disposed of.

Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed.

The petitioner may approach the Court again, if need be.
