Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.33 dated 28.03.2012 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code pertaining to Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran, on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 01.08.2016, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

Consequently, parties appeared before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran and got recorded their statements for compromise.

Report from the concerned Magistrate vide her covering letter No.61 dated

09.09.2016 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran vide Endst. No.1892-R dated 09.09.2016 has also been received.

According to the report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran, the compromise between the parties is voluntary, without any pressure.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.33, qua the petitioners, is quashed.
