Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.73 dated 24.08.2013 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B, IPC registered at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar (Annexure P/1) along with all consequential criminal proceedings arising thereof.

This petition was ordered to be listed along with **CRM-M-8418-2014**.

In view of the fact that after recording the entire prosecution evidence and statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C., the case is fixed for final hearing, CRM-M-8418 of 2014 is rendered as infructuous qua Gurvinder Singh who has faced the trial vide a separate order passed in that case.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI, Hans Raj submitted that all the three petitioners namely, Shingara Singh, Balwinder Singh and Gruinder Singh have already been declared proclaimed offender during the pendency of the present petition. Therefore, this petition is also rendered as infructuous.

However, it will be open for the petitioners to challenge the order declaring them proclaimed offender in accordance with law.
