Petitioner is an accused of offence under Section 379-B IPC. The FIR was registered by Tirath Kaur with the allegations that on 03.10.2016, when her husband was away to his work in the morning, the accused duly armed with *datar* came to the house of the complainant and put her under threat of giving injuries by *datar* and forcibly took away the gold ornaments weighing about 8.5 *to/as* and 800 pounds in cash.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh submitted that the petitioner has antecedent behaviour of such activities including a case under NDPS Act.

Having considered the allegations, I am of the view that petitioner is not entitled to the extra ordinary relief of anticipatory bail in the given situation.

Petition stands dismissed.
