Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.2, dated 19th February, 2016 registered under Sections 406, 420, 494 IPC at Police Station NRI, Ludhiana City, District Ludhiana.

The petitioner is admittedly, residing in New Zealand. In this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner had sought time on 14th April, 2017 in order to enable the petitioner to execute a Power of Attorney in favour of someone, who would represent the petitioner for an out of the Court settlement, if any.
