Petitioner-Rajdavinder Singh alias Rajwinder Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.61 dated 23.04.2015, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, under Sections 308, 323, 324, 341, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

On asking of the Court, Mr. V.P.S.Sidhu, Asstt. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.
