AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had been admitted to regular bail by the learned Special Court, Tarn Taran, on 10.10.2014, and thereafter he was coming present as and when summoned by that Court. However, on 23.12.2016, he could not come present as allegedly his counsel had noted the wrong date.

He further submits that on no other occasion was the petitioner ever absent from the Court proceedings.

This petition seeking anticipatory bail is dismissed. However, upon the petitioner surrendering before the learned trial Court, if the contention is found to be correct that he could not come present only on one date, i.e. 23.12.2016, and on no other date before that, that Court would admit him to bail to its satisfaction, subject to an undertaking that he would continue to appear before that Court as and when summoned.

It is made clear that if the petitioner has been absent on earlier

dates also, this order would be deemed to have not been passed.
