INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Jang Bahadur Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.130 dated 07.06.2016, registered at Police Station Kotwali Faridkot, District Faridkot, under Sections 341, 324, 323, 148, 149 and 506 IPC and Section 326 IPC added later on.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the petitioner has been named in the FIR. He has been stated to be armed with *kappa* and has caused grievous injury on the right side of head of the complainant.

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Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts that the petitioner was armed with deadly weapon and caused injury on the vital part of body of the complainant and further that he is required for custodial interrogation as weapon is still to be recovered, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
