of grant of back wages from the date of termination of respondent No. 1 to
the date of his demand notice, which has been granted by the Labour Court,
Gurdaspur vide its Award dated 23.01.2002.

Mr. Paramjit Singh-respondent No. 1, who appears in person,
states that he has been granted the back wages except for the period from
the date of his termination till the date of his demand notice, which has been
stayed by this Court. He states that he foregoes his claim for the said period
i.e. from 19.07.1996 till 10.09.1998.

In the light of the statement made by respondent No. 1 in Court
today, Mr. Jagdev Singh, A.E., representative of the petitioner, states that all
the consequential benefits shall be granted to respondent No. 1-Paramjit

period from 19.07.1996 till 10.09.1998, for which back wages have been given up by respondent No. 1.

In the light of the above compromise, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

C.M. No. 21882 of 2004

In view of the disposal of the main petition, no separate orders are required to be passed in this application and, therefore, the same stands dismissed.
