When the matter came up for hearing on April 25, 2017 the
Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that initially the FIR was registered for the offences of rash and negligent driving. Thereafter, offence under Section 15 of the NDPS Act was inserted on the statement of the owner that the car in question was given to Shami and the petitioner. Shami has been arrested and there is nothing incriminating against the petitioner in the disclosure statement of aforesaid Shami.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 30.04.2017 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Today, Mr. A.A. Pathak, Addl. AG, Punjab appears and
informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation. The

petitioner will continue to cooperate with the police in the investigation.

Accordingly, the interim bail is made absolute subject to the conditions in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
