Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that petitioner has been arrested in a counter version of FIR No.33 dated 20.4.2017 and presently he is behind bars. Therefore, the part of prayer for providing protection to him has become redundant.

As regards carrying out of impartial and fair investigation in the FIR, learned State counsel informs that as a result of investigation, challan has been prepared and filed against four persons out of 12 named as culprits by the complainant, in that way the investigation is complete. Learned State counsel also informs that an inquiry against remaining eight accused is still going on and supplementary challan may be filed against them, if found to be involved in the incident. If the complainant has got any grouse regarding involvement of other persons in

the incident then during the trial, an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. can be made for summoning of such persons as additional accused to face trial with persons challaned by the police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition and he would avail of the remedy under law for which necessary permission be granted to him.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as
aforementioned.
