Pursuant to the order dated 02.05.2017, a status report by way of affidavit of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran has been filed in Court today by learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, stating therein that a copy of the MLR and x-ray report of Gurjit Singh, brother of petitioner No.2, was received at Police Station Sadar, Patti, by MHC Santokh Singh, but was not handed over to the Investigating Officer, for which departmental action has been initiated against the aforesaid MHC Santokh Singh.

It is further stated that upon the aforesaid MLR and x-ray report having been produced by Gurjit Singh, his statement was recorded and a cross-version to the FIR has been registered,

vide DDR No.23 dated 12.05.2017, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 452/ 326/ 506/148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Patti.

Learned State counsel further, on instructions from ASI Puran Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined investigation and in the aforesaid circumstances, their custodial interrogation is not required.

Consequently, the interim order dated 25.04.2017 is made absolute, on the same terms.
