**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.**

Report dated 11.05.2017 of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dhuri has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Jasvir Singh and the accused persons namely Hakam Singh and Swaran Singh @ Gora, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise Ex.A1 has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the fact that the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and**

another' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and 'Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.0013 dated 04.03.2017 registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
