Prayer in the application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure is for disposal/decision of the present case regarding partition proceedings of the land, in view of the decision dated 21.09.2016/28.11.2016 regarding title of the suit land by this Court in RSA No.2978 of 1987 between the parties.

The partition proceedings under Section 111 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act are still pending before the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Khanna. An application raising question of title in the partition proceedings was moved, but the same was dismissed and ultimately, all the authorities have also dismissed the application. The question of title has been decided by this Court in RSA No.2978 of 1987 vide order dated 21.09.2016 and the

review of the same vide order dated 28.11.2016.

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition with the liberty to the parties to take all possible pleas available to them in accordance with law, much less, in terms of findings recorded in the regular second appeal before the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Khanna.

This Court is sanguine of the fact that the competent authority shall decide the partition proceedings in a most pragmatic and reasonable manner, much less, in accordance with law and as expeditiously as possible.

With the aforesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
