Though learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that he knows nothing about the case other than the fact the petitioners are seeking protection of their lives and liberty, learned State counsel has placed on record a short reply by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punhana, on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

As per the said affidavit, the petitioners were joined in enquiry by the police and they stated that they are now residing happily in village Neemka and they have no apprehension of danger from the private respondents, i.e. respondents no.4 to 8.

Similarly, as per the said affidavit, statements of respondents no.4, 5 and 7 have also been got recorded, to the effect that they would not create any problem or endanger the lives and liberty of the petitioners.

It has been further stated in the said affidavit that as regards the first husband of petitioner no.1, i.e. respondent no.8, Saikul son of Aamin, he was not present at home as he had gone out of station for his job but (as

per enquiry conducted), petitioner no.1 has obtained a divorce from her first husband, who on telephonic communication is stated to have told the police, that he would not create any danger for the petitioners.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, though with a direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to otherwise ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioners continue to be protected, within the four corners of law.
