The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 39, dated 20.03.2017, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had taken blank cheques as security from the complainant, who was his employee and filled an amount of ₹1,50,000/-.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 24.05.2017, had directed that in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he would be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC

Balwinder Kumar states that in pursuance to the order dated 24.05.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 24.05.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
