Petitioner-Amit @ Mita has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.326 dated 19.09.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonapat, under Sections 307, 458, 506 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (however challan presented under Sections 307, 450, 506 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959).

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that the present petitioner is not named in the FIR. Neither any role has been attributed to him, nor he is stated to be armed with any weapon. He has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused. Otherwise also, it is a case of no injury.

The petitioner has been in custody since 23.09.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
