Petitioner-Dharamvir, has filed this petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to register an FIR against respondents No.4 to 6 and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that a direction may be given to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Jind, to decide the representation dated 07.04.2017, moved by the petitioner and he does not press the other relief(s) asked in this petition.

In view of above, Superintendent of Police, Jind-respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation dated 07.04.2017 (Annexure P-7) independently, within 2 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, without being influenced by this order.
