Learned counsel for the petitioner alleged that civil action initiated by respondent No.5 by way of filing civil suit for specific performance is sought to be converted in a criminal overtone by respondent No.5 in collusion with the police.

Learned counsel further alleged that civil suit in respect of agreement to sell dated 23.11.2015 at the instance of respondent No.5 is also pending before the civil Court. Petitioner is being compelled to execute the sale deed even prior to the decision of the civil suit.

Precisely, for the grievance in question, petitioner has already moved a complaint to respondent No.2 on two occasions i.e. 19.03.2016 and 20.04.2016, but no action has been taken by the police in the context of protecting the civil rights of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shilesh Gupta, Addl, AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-State.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon reply.

This petition is disposed of at this stage without meaning anything on the ultimate merits of the case. Respondent No.2 is directed to take notice of pending representations before him and pass appropriate order in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
