The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in a case CRA No.19 of 2015 titled as Vijay Aggarwal versus Roshan Lal, arising out of criminal Complaint No.1027 dated 02.08.2013 (Annexure P- 10).

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the complainant has received the amount of ₹5,000/- and is entitled to the amount of ₹70,000/- deposited with the Registry of this Court pursuant to order dated 30.05.2017. He further submitted that he has no objection for confirming interim bail to the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-14005 OF 2017 is allowed.

- (ii) The petitioner is directed to join the investigation and fully cooperate with the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on *ad-interim* anticipatory bail in this case, on furnishing of his bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
- (iii) The amount of ₹70,000/- deposited by the petitioner in the Registry, shall be paid to Roshan Lal-complainant within a period of fifteen days from today.
- (iv) A copy of this order be placed before the Sessions Judge, Amabla who shall thereafter dispose of the appeal pending there in terms of the order that was made by Lok Adalat.
