The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No.45, dated 12.06.2016, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 275 grams of intoxicant powder was effected from the petitioner. Report of the Chemical Examiner has revealed the salt of alprazolam. The alleged recovery effected from the petitioner would be construed as heavy and commercial.

In view of the specific bar envisaged under Section 37 of the NDPS Act, prayer made in the instant petition seeking relief of regular bail is declined.

Petition is dismissed.
