The petitioner, whose land was acquired, has impugned the award dated 12.9.1999 passed by the Land Acquisition Tribunal, Ludhiana Improvement Trust, Ludhiana (for short 'the Tribunal'), in an application under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (for short, 'the Act'), in terms of an earlier award.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the earlier award relied upon by the Tribunal was subject matter of consideration before this Court in CWP No. 2943 of 1986 Ujagar Singh and others vs The Land Acquisition Tribunal, Ludhiana Improvement Trust, Ludhiana and others, which was disposed of on 7.10.2009. He further submitted that the petitioner be granted same relief as have been granted to other landowners pertaining to the same acquisition.

Learned counsel for respondent nos. 2 and 3 could not dispute the aforesaid factual position.

As for the acquired land in question, valuation was under consideration in Ujagar Singh's case (supra), the landowners in the present petition are also entitled to seek relief as has been granted to other landowners in Ujagar Singh's case (supra).

Ordered accordingly.

While modifying the award of the Tribunal to that extent, the present petition is disposed of.
