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Power of Attorney on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed
today by Mr.I.D.Singla, Advocate, which has been placed on the record.

The matter has been discussed. It has been stated by Suresh
Chand - respondent No.1 that he has already been reinstated in service by
the petitioner and he does not want to press for payment of back-wages as
per award passed by the Labour Court. He has further stated that he gives
up his claim for back-wages and that hence, the present writ petition has
become infructuous.

It has been stated by learned DAG, Haryana and representative
of the petitioner that respondent No.1 was already reinstated in service and
his services have also been regularized. It has been further stated that the
dispute was only regarding back-wages and as respondent No.1 has
relinquished his claim for back-wages, the present writ petition has become
infructuous and that hence, the petitioner does not want to proceed further
with this writ petition and the same be dismissed as withdrawn.
