Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record receipt regarding payment of Rs.1,28,000/- on 15.09.2017 and has undertaken that henceforth he will be paying the entire balance amount in four equal installments w.e.f. 01.10.2017 and in case of two consecutive defaults the Company may proceed ahead as per law.

Learned counsel for respondent No.5 agreed to this arrangement so canvassed by learned counsel for the petitioner and has undertaken that Company would not proceed ahead and abide by this arrangement so arrived at in the Court reserving its right to proceed ahead into the matter on default of this undertaking of the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed off in those terms. The

parties shall be bound by their undertakings.
