Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty and to restrain respondent No.4 not to take any illegal action for harassing or humiliating the petitioners.

On 26.04.2017, the following order has been passed:-

“ Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have married against the wishes of respondent No. 4 and parents of petitioners are willing for this marriage. He further submits that the petitioners have no proof regarding their age and filed separate affidavits stating that they are major.

Notice of motion for 09.08.2017.

In the meanwhile, respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, is directed to take appropriate steps to secure the life and liberty of the petitioners, as per representation (Annexure P-4) given by petitioner No. 1.

However, it is made clear that nothing contained in this order shall be interpreted as giving protection to the petitioners against any legal action to be taken in any civil, criminal or other proceedings instituted/initiated/pending against them.”

On the last date of hearing i.e. on 09.08.2017, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner and no process fee has been filed for effecting service upon respondent No.4. It is the same situation as on today as neither the petitioner is present nor any process fee has been filed for effecting service upon him.

In view of the order dated 26.04.2017, this petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again, in case, there is still any threat to their lives and liberty.
