Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.89 dated 15.07.2012, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Sections 452 IPC deleted lateron), registered at Police Station GhallKhurd, District Ferozepur, the petitioners seek quashing of the said FIR on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondents No.2 submit that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording of statements. Pursuant thereto, now, there is a report from learned JMIC, Ferozepur stating that the statements have been recorded and the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or pressure.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. FIR No.89 dated 15.07.2012, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 of IPC (Sections 452 IPC deleted lateron), registered at Police Station GhallKhurd, District Ferozepur alongwith all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
