Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents in the context of protecting his life and personal liberty on the ground that petitioner knows one Piara Singh-respondent No.6 who has some financial dispute with one Balwinder Singh.

Balwinder Singh has already filed complaint against Piara Singh under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. Piara Singh has filed complaint against the petitioner in respect of alleged stealing of cheques which have been made subject matter of proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act by Balwinder Singh.

Petitioner alleges that in the aforesaid context, the police is unnecessarily harassing him for which he has also

moved representation to respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied if his pending representation before respondent No.3 is directed to be decided by way of passing a speaking order. Copy of undated reply has been attached as Annexure P-4.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Ghuman, Additional A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

At this stage, in view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing any reply to the petition as no order prejudicial to interest of any of the party is being passed.

At this stage, without meaning anything on merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to have a fair look at the grievance of the petitioner and pass appropriate order in accordance with law.
