The present petition has been filed under Section 438
the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 74 dated
28.04.2016 registered under Sections 323, 324, 354-B, 354, 452 and
148 read with Section 149 IPC at Police Station Basti Bawa Khel,
Jalandhar.

On 05.05.2017, this Court had passed the following
order:-

“Notice of motion for 11.08.2017.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation and
appear before the investigating officer. In the event of arrest, the
petitioner be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of
the arresting/investigating officer. However, the petitioner shall
join investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall
remain bound by the following conditions enumerated under

Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

1. Petitioner shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. Petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
3. Petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court; 4. Such other condition as may be imposed under subsection (3) of section 437, as if the bail were granted under that section.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 05.05.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 05.05.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
