Prayer in this petition is for quashing of F.I.R No. 157 dated 19.06.2015, registered at P.S. City Barnala under Sections 406/498-A/506 IPC.

Learned counsel at the very outset does not press this petition qua petitioner No. 1 and states that the parties mediated with Ms. Dhiman, Mediator and Ms. Surinder Kaur, Human Right Activitist but mediation has failed between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners after arguing for some time, wishes to withdraw the petition with a liberty to take all the pleas before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

Keeping in view the above fact that the allegations levelled against petitioner Nos 2 to 7 are general in nature, their personal appearance is exempted before the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:- (i) petitioners shall be represented through counsel; (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings; (iii) shall not dispute their identity as an accused; (iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence but in the presence of their counsel; (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court; and (vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
