The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 01, dated 3rd/4th January, 2017, registered under Sections 22/25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa.

Custody certificate of petitioner No.1 is filed in the Court today; Be kept on record.

Heard both sides.

It transpires that recovery of 12 vials of Corex Syrup, weighing 1200 ml. in all, and 12 Strips of Carisoma Tablets, totaling to 120 tablets, was effected from the petitioners, which is marginally above the commercial quantity.

Admittedly, the petitioners are not involved in any other case of similar nature.

In the given circumstances, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioners, namely Kuldeep Singh @ Bandi and Amandeep Singh @ Amni, in this case, are directed to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court concerned, subject to the compliance of the conditions, if any, imposed by the Ld. Trial Court.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed off.
