This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.94 dated 06.07.2016, under Sections 363, 366-A, 380, 457, 120-B IPC (now challaned under Sections 363, 366, 376-D, 120-B IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act), registered at Police Station, Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that daughter of the complainant was 17 years and 11 months old. She had accompanied the petitioner and sought protection vide order dated 08.07.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Sessions Judge, Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed that now the prosecutrix has got married elsewhere.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this

petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular

bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial
Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fatehgarh Sahib.
