AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)

A perusal of the order dated 2.5.2017 shows that it was considered appropriate that the petitioner be admitted to interim bail upon furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, but inadvertently what has also been stated in the order is that "upon his surrendering before the learned trial Court" which obviously cannot be, as the petitioner is already in custody.

For the reasons already stated in the order dated 2.5.2017, to the effect that there is no other case seen to be

registered against the petitioner as per the custody certificate, and not even one witness examined and the quantity recovered from him being only 138 gms of contraband, further with him being in custody for more than 5-1/2 months as of today, the interim order dated 2.5.2017 is made absolute during the pendency of trial.
