Petitioner-Pardeep @ Biliya has filed this 3rd petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.51 dated 24.02.2015, registered at Police Station Khol, District Rewari, under Sections 302, 386, 450, 34 and 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been got registered by Surender Singh. As per the allegations, on 23.02.2015, at about 09.30 p.m, he alongwith Ankit and Vikas were taking dinner in his room. At that time, Vipin, Zorawar, Neeraj and one unknown boy came there and Vipin asked Vikas to give money. When Vikas questioned Vipin about the base of demand of money, then Zorawar took out pistol from his pant and fired towards Vikas which hit on his face. When the complainant party started running here and there, all the four persons ran away from the room. However, when the complainant and others tried to catch the aforesaid four persons, then Neeraj took out his pistol and fired towards them. As per the impugned order dated 31.03.2017, the present petitioner was also present alongwith those boys.

Keeping in view the active participation of the present petitioner in the commission of offence and in view of nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
