Petitioner-Manish Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.158 dated 27.12.2016, registered at Police Station Sadhaura, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 307 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that though the petitioner has been named in the FIR, but he has not been stated to be armed with any specific weapon. As per the FIR, no injury has been attributed to him.

The petitioner has been in custody since 07.01.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
