This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.26 dated 26.6.2015 under sections 406, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B I.P.C and sections 13(1)(d) of Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station, S.V.B., Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered against the Sarpanch, Panches and other officials of the Rural Development & Panchayat Department, Haryana on the allegations that as opposed to utilization of funds for construction of a Community Centre in the village, four streets have been constructed.

The present petitioner is sought to be implicated on the basis that he was an associate of a co-accused Jitender, who was a contractor and had been assigned the work of construction of the four streets.

Petitioner was arrested on 20.3.2017.

Even though, investigation is yet underway, it has gone uncontroverted that other co-accused including Sarpanch, Panches and officials of the Rural Development & Panchayat Department have been

granted benefit of regular bail by this Court.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Hisar.

Petition disposed of.
