On 27.04.2017, following order was passed by this

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that
in respect of an occurrence dated 24.02.2017, the FIR
came to be registered on 27.02.2017. The allegation
against the petitioner is of dragging the complainant by leg.*

Notice of motion for 29.05.2017.

*In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear
before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on
05.05.2017 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be
enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of
Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the
conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that

pursuant to the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The aforesaid fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Major Singh. Learned counsel further stated that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of above, interim order dated 27.04.2017 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
