The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.48, dated 08.05.2016, under Sections 323, 342, 294, 506, 379-B, 148, 149 IPC(Section 365 IPC added & deleted, subsequently) registered at Police Station Division 6, Jalandhar City, District Jalandhar(Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise(Annexure P-3) dated 17.04.2017 arrived at between the parties.

Vide order dated 27.04.2017, the petitioners and respondents No.2 to 4 were directed to appear before the learned Area Magistrate for getting their statements recorded.

In compliance thereof, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, has submitted its report to the effect that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine and without any force or pressure.

Even before this Court there is no dispute regarding the compromise.

In view of the above, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and that is not only for the betterment of warring groups, but a semblance for the growth of society. Consequently, this Court is satisfied that it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR as well as proceedings resulting therefrom.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. FIR No.48, dated 08.05.2016 under Sections 323, 342, 294, 506, 379-B, 148, 149 IPC(Section 365 IPC added & deleted, subsequently) registered at Police Station Division 6, Jalandhar City, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) alongwith all consequential proceedings are hereby quashed.
