Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondent No.2 for protection of her civil rights which were duly acknowledged by the civil Court by passing an order of status quo in favour of her father-in-law in a civil suit.

Petitioner further alleges that despite the interim order in their favour, respondent No.4 is instrumental in violating her civil rights for which a representation dated 14.03.2017 has been moved by her before respondent No.2. The said representation has not been decided by respondent No.2 so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied if her pending representation is decided by respondent No.2 by way of passing a speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Ghuman, Additional A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, in view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing any reply to the petition as no order prejudicial to interest of any of the party is being passed.

At this stage, without meaning anything on merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to look into the pending representation of the petitioner and pass appropriate order in accordance with law.
