Petitioner is accused of offence under Sections 306/34
IPC in a case bearing FIR No.23 dated 24.02.2017 registered at
Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

The FIR was registered at the instance of complainant
Yashpal Jindal who alleged that his brother Rakesh Kumar was
working as salesman with Rajinder Aggarwal @ Kaka at
Manimajra, Chandigarh. Rakesh Kumar did not pay his salary
and used to delay the same for one reason or the other.
Brother of the complainant having fed up with the aforesaid
event, conveyed to the complainant that he would end his life.

In the meanwhile, the brother of the complainant came in contact with the petitioner who was involved in the act of gambling. Brother of the complainant also involved in gambling. An amount of Rs.1 lac was allegedly taken by the petitioner from him and non-payment thereof allegedly provided stimulus to commit suicide by the deceased.

Learned State counsel on instructions of ASI Rajbir Singh, submits that the challan has not been presented. No recovery has been effected from the petitioner. Ingredients of abetting the commission of crime in respect of offence under Section 306 IPC would remain on debatable note.

In view of above, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
